Your submission was complete as of March 28, 2012. EPA has 90 days from this date to render a decision about the acceptability of R-441A in the specified end use. You were allowed to sell R-441A for use in stand-alone refrigerator and freezers in retail food refrigeration in the U.S. as of June 27, 2012, pending EPA's decision. EPA will notify you in a letter of our preliminary determination.
